For instance, Breton (CVE-10) became Royal Navy Escort Carriers - Cdr. David Hobbs Dec 9, 2013 . During World War II the Royal Navy took delivery of 45 Escort carriers, only 5 were lost including HMS Dasher which blew up (cause unknown);
